SUBJECT: 19th Avenue Corridor Study

The 19th Avenue Corridor Study, has been prepared by the San Francisco Planning Department pursuant to San Francisco Board of Supervisors Resolution Nos. 080014 and 080015, adopted on October 20, 2008. This legislation requires that a comprehensive cumulative impact study encompassing all reasonably foreseeable developments located along the 19th Avenue Corridor Study area be prepared and continually updated by the San Francisco Planning Department and Municipal Transportation Authority. (Please note that although the study includes the proposed Parkmerced Project among the projects considered in the analysis, it has been prepared only pursuant to the legislation noted above and is not intended to fulfill the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.)
