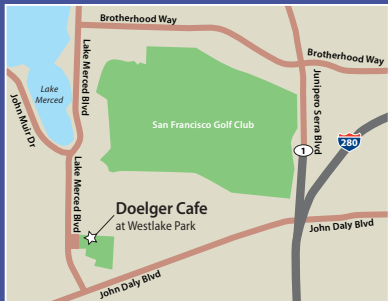
Join us February 23rd for a public workshop on parking and environmental sustainability.
