

Parkmerced Community Meeting
Meeting Summary
January 27, 2010

The following is a summary of comments and questions noted during the January 27 community meeting.

- Concerned city's legislation doesn't go far enough with respect to project sponsors paying for their fair share of transportation improvements
- Has the study considered elevation changes at certain locations? These changes are concerning.
- What will be the impacts to the #17 bus?
- There will be many impacts on the southbound 19th Avenue corridor. The mitigations must account for three new crossing points and related traffic impacts (particularly with proposed re-routing of MUNI).
- The study should consider extending Palmetto to provide a fourth lane on northbound Junipero Serra.
- Adding longer, 3-car MUNI trains will create greater traffic impacts. This should be studied.
- To what extent are other plans to increase density in San Francisco corridors (such as 19th Avenue) being pursued? Any federal or local plans?
- It would be better to focus improvement efforts on a more direct plan for MUNI trains, such as the SFSU early plans to move tracks to the west side of 19th Avenue. This would mean the train would not route into Parkmerced.
- What are the specifics of the housing plan? How many units would be removed? How many would be rentals and how many would be sold?
- How would students and employees at SFSU cross Holloway at the new stop? Are there plans for an under- or overpass?
- What are the parking impacts?
- Who is paying for this?
- Does the new Chumasero design impact existing buildings?
- Why are there more access points? Won't that generate unnecessary traffic in Parkmerced?
- SFSU should pay its fair share of needed traffic improvements.
- What is the parking ratio? How does it compare to other areas in SF?
- How many families with children would be forced to move?
- What are the specifics of the Font and 19th Avenue proposal?
- How would residents access 19th Avenue/Junipero Serra?
- How many affordable housing units would be in place?
- Will new units have equivalent square footage to existing units?
- Will there be a walkway on Felix?
- Can anything be done at Eucalyptus about the conflicts between MUNI and automobile traffic?
- Can Parkmerced create dedicated student housing?
